I have been conducting monitoring visits to places of deprivation of liberty i.e. detention centres as a member of the National Preventive Mechanism (NPM) since 2011, firstly as a Macedonian NPM member (2011-2015), and later as a Croatian NPM member (2015-until today). For the purpose of performing that work, I needed to be in depth familiar with the CPT standards, reports, and other relevant international and domestic standards and criteria.

As an active member of the South-East Europe NPM Network since 2013, I am extensively acquainted with the situation in respect to places of deprivation of liberty in the countries of the South-East Europe.

During my professional years as a NPM member of the Republic of Macedonia, I visited all places of detention as well as places where there is de facto deprivation of liberty (open institutions for children, border check points' places, elderly' homes) and places of deprivation of liberty of migrants and asylum seeker. Throughout my work, I have conducted regular, follow up and ad hoc visits.

Since 2015 I have been a member of the Croatian NPM and I have continued to perform the same scope of work, thus among the national places of deprivation of liberty, I have had the opportunity to visit detention places of Slovenia, Montenegro, Albania, and Austria.

I have also had the opportunity to be part of several study visits and thus to enrich my knowledge and exchange experience with peer colleagues from other countries of the European Union, Spain, Denmark, Poland and Austria.

I strongly believe that my knowledge and acquired skills, along with my energy and passion to work in this particular field, shall contribute to further strengthening and enriching the CPT work.
