ON THE OBLIGATION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF CROATIA TO BEGIN THE PROCEDURE OF TERMINATION OF THE ARBITRATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF CROATIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SLOVENIA SIGNED ON 4TH NOVEMBER 2009

The Croatian Parliament puts the Government of the Republic of Croatia under an obligation to begin the procedure of termination of the Arbitration Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Croatia and the Government of the Republic of Slovenia, signed on 4th November 2009 in Stockholm, which was in force as of 29th November 2010, for reasons of material breach of its provisions by the Republic of Slovenia.
